Dragon Hall Bookstore

The Answers in Genesis' (AiG) Dragon Hall Bookstore shatters the typical images that volumes of books conjure up in people's minds. Instead of rows of books set in stuffy surroundings, Dragon Hall offers a wealth of Bible-affirming science, worldview and family resources in a dramatic setting.



Accessible through the museum's lobby, visitors approaching the bookstore entrance are met overhead by a large pterosaur, a flying reptile, perched atop a nest on what appears to be a solid-rock outcropping from the surrounding wall. *Dragon Hall Bookstore* is emblazoned underneath.

The bookstore concept grew into a 'dragon' theme because of the correlation between dinosaurs in the museum and the prominence of dragon stories in every culture. Many dragon legends discovered in civilizations around the world indicate that ancient people were familiar with what we now call dinosaurs.

The bookstore's features were created almost entirely by Answers in Genesis' artists. Designed to resemble the library of a large English manor, the bookstore comes complete with a large faux-fireplace, towering bookcases, large brick walls, stained glass windows, a huge candelabrum, artwork depicting medieval shields and a pillared bas-relief sculpture of St. George's duel with the dragon.

Though Dragon Hall is an extension of the museum experience, it is a fully functional bookstore. Visitors will find Bibles, Bible reference tools, homeschool curricula, financial resources, family materials, award-winning AiG DVDs, AiG best-sellers and gifts... in addition to enjoying the adventures of their surroundings.
