



## Answers in Genesis Fact Sheet

The Creation Museum is the newest and most visible ministry outreach of Answers in Genesis (AiG). Founded in 1994 by president Ken Ham, chief communications officer Mark Looy and museum vice-president Mike Zovath, AiG headquarters are located in Petersburg, Ky., in the same building as the museum. In 13 years, the organization has grown to more than 200 employees and is one of the largest apologetics ministries in the world. Other ministry purposes and distinctions include:

- ◆ AiG hosts more than 350 teaching events across the United States each year
- ◆ More than 120,000 people are active contributors or resource customers of AiG
- ◆ So many people order AiG DVDs, books and magazines that the ministry is one of UPS' biggest customers in the northern Kentucky region the month preceding Christmas
- ◆ AiG produces a daily radio feature called *Answers...with Ken Ham*, that airs on over 860 domestic stations and over 450 international outlets
- ◆ In 2005, the *Answers...with Ken Ham* radio feature was nominated as the National Religious Broadcasters' (NRB) best teaching program
- ◆ AiG's Web site, [www.answersingenesis.org](http://www.answersingenesis.org) receives 30,000 hits per day
- ◆ In 2006, [www.answersingenesis.org](http://www.answersingenesis.org), became first in category of 1,300 other ministries to win the prestigious NRB "Web site of the year" award
- ◆ In 2006, AiG began publishing *Answers* magazine - an insightful scientific and family resource dedicated to spreading a biblical worldview - that is growing by 1,500 subscriptions per month
- ◆ AiG is a non-profit ministry in good standing with the Evangelical Council for Financial Accountability, a respected financial supervisory body that reviews AiG's records each year
- ◆ In 2005 and 2006, AiG was chosen over thousands of ministries to be named "one of the 30 shining lights" by MinistryWatch.com, another financial watchdog of non-profit ministries
