Opening of the 70,000 square foot Creation Museum—an evangelistic walk through the Bible “international center”



2006

Website receives up to 30,000 daily visits and wins the prestigious “NRB website of the Year” award.



2004

AiG moves into the new headquarters and continues construction of the Creation Museum for 2007 grand opening.



2000

After years of legal impediments 47 acres in Northern Kentucky are purchased to be the future home of Answers in Genesis and its Museum.



1994

AiG’s “Answers” radio program is first broadcast on 70 stations. On 860 U.S. stations today.



1994

Ministry starts in Northern Kentucky; AiG’s first major seminar attracts 6,200 people in Denver.

Ken and Mally Ham move their family to America, and Ken joins the Institute for Creation Research in San Diego, California.



1979

Ken Ham, public school science teacher, launches creation ministry in Australia.
